News From Unit 107

Rank Changes: Gold Life Master: Les Ward.

Board of Directors – Please thank the Board members who completed their terms – Don Moyer, Dick Thudium, Carol Helderlein and Jim Sullivan. They took care of the business of the Unit and performed many volunteer functions. Jon Wendelken, Alper Buldum, Jim Coleman, Mina Ronen and Marv Shapiro were elected to three-year terms. Congratulations to all of them. The new Board then elected Rick Roberts, President, Jim Sullivan, Vice President, Lewis Sage, Secretary and Judy Taylor, Treasurer.

EVER BEEN DECLARER AND HAD A LEAD OUT OF TURN: You are getting ready to play as declarer and down comes a lead from the wrong hand (face up). The Director comes over and rattles off your choices and there you go into deep thought or guess work. Just what are the choices and what should you do.

There are five choices:

- 1) You accept the lead and become dummy letting your partner play the hand. In effect you hand the declarer position over to your partner.
- 2) You accept the lead and see dummy before playing from your hand.
- 3) You require the lead of the suit led from the proper hand. With this choice 2 things happen: the card lead is picked up (the player does not have to play that card; and the proper player must continue to lead that suit as long as they retain the lead (at this time).

4) You forbid the lead of the suit led from the proper hand. With this choice the same things apply as number 3 with the exception that this player is forbidden to lead the suit as long as they retain the lead.

5) You may let the appropriate player lead anything they desire. The card led remains on the table and must be played at the first legal opportunity. If the card is still on the table and the partner of the offender gets on lead again – declarer gets choices 3, 4 and 5 each time.

NOTE: Number 3, 4 and 5 are available whenever a lead out of turn is made by defense, along with accepting the lead.

Which should you choose? Depends on the bidding and what you wish to accomplish. Also remember, if a suit is required to be led and the player does not have any, they can lead anything.

Of course, ALL OF THIS CAN BE AVOIDED if the opening lead is ALWAYS made face down. (Just remember if you are the proper leader you can not change the card led even though no one has seen it.) If the proper player has made the lead the card is simply turned over. If it is not the proper player the card goes back in the hand and the correct player makes the lead.
