ARE YOU SLOWING THE GAME: You are if you are writing down the contract and/or putting away your bidding cards instead of selecting and placing your lead face down on the table. You would think this is a minimal amount of time but actually it is a lot more than you think. Because if the lead is from the correct player, dummy can be faced before the card is even turned over. Leader can then write

the score and replace bidding cards. These seconds multiplied by the number of boards can amount to a substantial amount of time lost. This is also the most polite way to lead and is encouraged by ACBL.

You are if cards are removed from the board and talk continues. This is against the ACBL rules and is illegal.

You are if you continue to discuss the hand just finished or worse another hand before completing the boards for your round. This is also against ACBL rules.
